SHELLING OUT BOOKS

Grades: 3-6

Objective: Students will explore the concept of trade using

wampum.

Materials: beads representing wampum

old books used books donated books

Procedure:

1. Students will bring in old or used books.

- 2. Books will be displayed throughout the classroom.
- 3. Students will be given wampum to use as a purchasing tool for the books.
- 4. Students will determine a wampum value on each book for trading session (ex. two wampum is equal to a chapter book).
- 5. Students will peruse the book display and write a wish list.
- 6. Each student will be assigned a number then all numbers will be drawn randomly.
- 7. Student will use their wampum to purchase available books.
